



summary of train times

There is a choice of two train services and routes between Málaga and Sevilla - the old route and the new high speed line.

AVANT trains - shown in blue - operate via the high speed line. They are faster but more expensive.

MD trains - shown in red - operate via the old route. They are slower but cheaper, and the best scenery is on this route.

MD trains also call at Sevilla San Bernardo 3 minutes from Santa Justa. This station is closer to the city centre and linked to it by tram.
